(COVID-19 VARIOUS ROADS, MONMOUTH, MONMOUTHSHIRE)
EMERGENCY TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** of County Hall, The Rhadyr, Usk, NP15 1GA (“the Council”) pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 do **HEREBY DIRECT** that for the purpose of the following regulations shall be observed:

1. This shall come into operation on **23rd June 2020** and is expected to be in operation for **a maximum period of 21 days**.
2. This is necessary in order for the Council to provide various safety measures within the towns and villages of Monmouthshire because of the likelihood of danger to the public as a direct consequence of the coronavirus.
3. The effect will be to close a section of the following:
 - I. Monnow Street from its junction with Monnow Keep to its junction with St Johns Street (except for deliveries); and
 - II. St John Street from its junction with Glendower Street to its junction with Monnow Street (except for access)
4. Due to the nature of the works, motorists will be expected to find alternative routes, as these will not be signed.
5. This order may be cited as COVID-19 Various Roads, Monmouth, Monmouthshire Emergency Traffic Regulation Order 2020
6. By virtue of Section 16(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 a person who contravenes a restriction or prohibition imposed under Section 14 of the Act shall be guilty of an offence.
