## MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MONNOW STREET, AGINCOURT SQUARE, AGINCOURT STREET AND PRIORY STREET, MONMOUTH, MONMOUTHSHIRE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE 2020

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that **MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** of County Hall, The Rhadyr, Usk, NP15 1GA ("the Council") pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 did **HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT** that for the purpose of the following regulations shall be observed:

- The Order came into operation on the 15th June 2020 and will continue to be in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works were to be completed within 5 weeks, between 15th June and 20th July 2020.
- The order was necessary for works involved with the Monmouth Town Public Realm scheme carriageway to take place in a safe manner at the location. Reasonable access has been maintained for properties fronting the affected lengths of road during the period of the closure.
- 3. The effect of the order was to temporarily close sections of Monnow Street, Agincourt Square, Agincourt Street and Priory Street, Monmouth, Monmouthshire.
- 4. A signed diversionary route was put in place as follows:

Northbound: B4293 (Blestium Street), B4293 (Cinderhill Street), A40, A466 (Wyebridge Street), A466 (James Street), A466 (Monk Street), B4932 (Priory Street).

Southbound: B4293 (Priory Street), A466 (Dixton Road), A40, B4293 (Beech Road), B4293 (Portal Road), B4293 (Cinderhill Street), B4293 (Blestium Street).

## 5. This order may be cited as the Monnow Street, Agincourt Square, Agincourt Street and Priory Street, Monmouth, Monmouthshire Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020.

6. By virtue of Section 16(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 a person who contravenes a restriction or prohibition imposed under Section 14 of the Act shall be guilty of an offence.

## SCHEDULE

Monnow Street, Agincourt Square, Agincourt Street and Priory Street, Monmouth, Monmouthshire

Monnow Street: Closed from its junction with Agincourt Street/Agincourt Square to its junction with St John's Street.

Agincourt Square: Closed for its entirety. Agincourt Street: Closed from its junction with Agincourt Square/Monnow Street for ~45m. Priory Street: Closed from Agincourt Square for ~85m.
