1.	To Receive Declaration of Interest of Items on the Agenda: None received.

To Consider funding available through Section 106 Monies: Members considered the 12 schemes nominated for S106 money available. <ol style="list-style-type: none">A multi use games area in Monmouth. Money has already been earmarked.A fenced community area at Rockfield community field. Approved by this committee.A dog walking area. Money already earmarked.Increased lighting in the area of Rockfield community hall. This road has not yet been adopted by the County Council. This committee feels that lighting is the responsibility of the developers and should be installed before the road is adopted. We recommend refusal of this scheme.Walk and cycle ways in the wider area in Monmouthshire County Council. The committee is generally in favour of this scheme and would support a grant for direct works. However, the money required is for consultancy fees and we would recommend refusal for this purpose. We feel that the proposers of this scheme need to do more work before money should be released. Possibly could be considered for the S106 money that will become available from the Nailors Lane development.	

	<p>6. Barriers around the football pitch. This is to be amended to include an upgrade for the pavilion and the request is now for £8,000. This committee approves this scheme.</p> <p>7. Other facilities for spectators etc at the Sports ground. This should not come out of S106 money and this committee recommends refusal.</p> <p>8. Improvement to play facilities at Chippenham. This committee recommends refusal as this money is specifically for adult recreation.</p> <p>9. Move the skate park nearer to Rockfield estate. Refusal for same reason as above.</p> <p>10. Informal BMX park. Refusal for same reason as above.</p> <p>11. Barriers at Monmouth Leisure Centre. This committee strongly objects to this scheme, as this should be paid for out of the Capital expenditure budget for the leisure centre. S106 money should not be used to provide parking facilities.</p> <p>12. Practice boats for the rowing club. Recommend approval. The committee was particularly concerned about scheme number 12.</p>	<p>Clerk e-mail or fax MCC Area committee to highlight our concern that S106 money may possibly spent on this proposal (Item 12).</p>
<p>4.</p>	<p>To Agree Funding contribution to Veterans Day Celebrations: The Community Committee also recommended that we should donate £200 to the Veterans day currently being organised by the Royal British Legion. This is to come from the money available under the Community Grants scheme.</p>
