MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COVID-19 VARIOUS ROADS, MONMOUTH, MONMOUTHSHIRE) EMERGENCY TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** of County Hall, The Rhadyr, Usk, NP15 1GA ("the Council") pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 do **HEREBY DIRECT** that for the purpose of the following regulations shall be observed:

- 1. This shall come into operation on **23rd June 2020** and is expected to be in operation for **a maximum** period of **21 days**.
- 2. This is necessary in order for the Council to provide various safety measures within the towns and villages of Monmouthshire because of the likelihood of danger to the public as a direct consequence of the coronavirus.
- 3. The effect will be to close a section of the following:
 - I. Monnow Street from its junction with Monnow Keep to its junction with St Johns Street (except for deliveries); and
 - II. St John Street from its junction with Glendower Street to its junction with Monnow Street (except for access)
- 4. Due to the nature of the works, motorists will be expected to find alternative routes, as these will not be signed.
- 5. This order may be cited as COVID-19 Various Roads, Monmouth, Monmouthshire Emergency Traffic Regulation Order 2020
- 6. By virtue of Section 16(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 a person who contravenes a restriction or prohibition imposed under Section 14 of the Act shall be guilty of an offence.
