Monmouth Town Council Pollinator Policy Version 1- 03/08/2020

- 1. The Town Council shall use its status as consultee for planning applications with due regard to the positive and negative effects any future developments pose to the environment.
- 2. Where direct control of land management does not exist the Town Council will use its role to influence local agencies/ land owners, places of worship, community growing groups, allotments etc. to adopt the same approach to the management of their land.
- 3. The Town council will use the pollinator policy to support further trial areas for the non-spraying of glyphosate of "weeds" and actively work with the Highways department to suggest sites for these trials.
- 4. The pollinator policy will become the umbrella under which community groups and agencies will work with the Town Council on a unified approach to the strategic aims of the Climate Emergency, ACE and Monmouth Bee Town.
- 5. MTC has undertaken to maintain this status (Bee Friendly/Caru Gwenyn Status)
